ADULT CPR AED



Tap and shout.

Shout for help.

Phone 9-1-1 and place phone on speaker mode so you can talk to the dispatcher, or send someone else to phone 9-1-1 and get an AED.





Look for no breathing or only gasping.

Push hard and fast in the center of the chest. Give 30 compressions.

- · Push straight down at least 2 inches.
- . Give 100 to 120 compressions per minute.
- · Let the chest come back up to its normal position.
- . Try not to interrupt compressions for more than 10 seconds.

Open the airway and give 2 breaths.







Repeat sets of 30 compressions and 2 breaths.

When the AED arrives, use it immediately. Turn it on and follow the prompts.
