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The renew by date will appear as a 2-digit month, 4-digit year, and 2 years from the issue date.

The Instructor ID is an added layer of security to ensure that each card can be traced back to a specific instructor, Training Center, and their internal course rosters.

All information on the eCard is digitally populated based on the information entered by a valid Training Center Coordinator or Instructor.

Employers may verify that an eCard is authentic by scanning the QR code on the eCard using a mobile device. Once the QR code is scanned, it will auto-populate the Instructor's credentials for the employee to verify.
